She currently is the principal investigator on a clinical trial examining a pharmacological intervention for younger patients with psychosis and glucose abnormalities.

She co-leads the Mental Health and Metabolic Clinic at the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (CAMH).

From a translational perspective, Dr. Hahn oversees a basic science laboratory and is also a member of the Banting & Best Diabetes Centre, U of T.
