WHAT TO BRING

VENUE

The Banting Homestead Heritage Park is a rural farmstead. It can be quite windy on occasion. The School Tour agenda includes a brief walk around the Banting Legacy Trail and an opportunity to use the exterior exercise equipment and exterior musical instruments during lunch break, weather permitting. Students should wear clothing suitable for outside activity and as appropriate for weather conditions.

FOOD

There is no food service at the tour site. Water is supplied. Students should bring a packed lunch.

Tours can be scheduled between 8:30 am and 4:00 pm daily excluding Sundays and mid-Dec to mid-Jan.
